- 2.Advise the Hon. Commissioner for Health and the Authorities of LGAs and LCDAs on matters regarding PHCs services in the state.
- 3.Improve/ establish policies in respect of primary health care implementation matters.
- 4.Ensure manpower planning, development and training in primary health care services.
- 5.Monitor the activities of Local Government Health Authorities.
- 6.Disburse funds to Local Government Health Authorities from National Primary Health Care development Agency and other sources.
- 7.Recruit and promote Primary Health Care staff in the state.
- 8.Handle Pensions.
